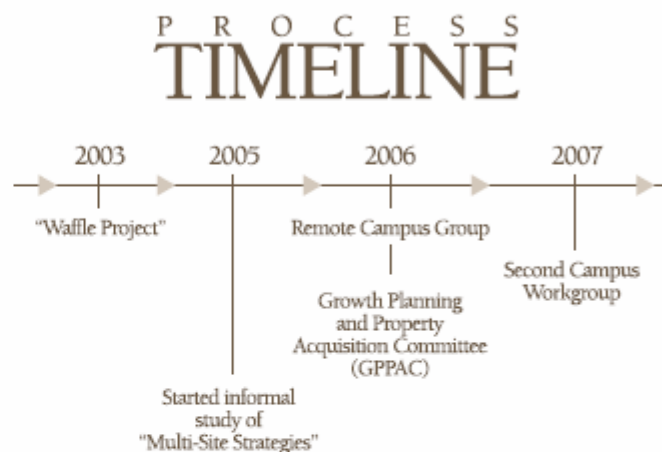


THE PROCESS

Since coming to Calvary over 5 years ago, I have been praying for God to lead us to have a Kingdom Vision. We have examined several different possibilities that would allow us to spread the Gospel of Jesus Christ in our city and the surrounding communities.

After months of research, discussion, and prayer we felt God leading us to start a Second Campus of Calvary Baptist Church in Davie County. This campus will be called Calvary Baptist Church West Campus!

Let me take a moment to remind you of the process that God took us through to lead us to the conclusion that starting a West Campus would be the most effective first step in our Kingdom Vision.



WHY Davie County?

There are several reasons we feel led to Davie County to start the West Campus. Some of those reasons:

Reason 1: Opportunities for the Gospel

Simply put, our motivation is the Gospel. You will see below there are pragmatic reasons why we selected Davie County for the site of our Second Campus. But the burden behind the vision is to see men and women, along with boys and girls, come to Jesus Christ through faith and repentance. With the growth trends that we discovered, we believe there is a strong need for more churches in that area which are passionate about the Gospel and seeing people come to Jesus Christ.

Reason 2: Consensus Among Staff and Leadership

For months we have wrestled with data and growth patterns along with the positives and negatives concerning various locations in our region. In every instance, God kept leading us in the direction of Davie County. Confirmation of our decision was revealed to us through the unanimous consensus of the staff, Second Campus Workgroup, GPPAC, and finally the deacons.

Reason 3: Proximity of Our Current Church Membership to Davie County

Part of our process in determining the location of our Second Campus was to study the demographics of our Central Campus. We believe it is imperative for the Second Campus to be strategically located within a reasonable distance of our church members and our Central Campus. Reason 4: Projected Growth of Davie County

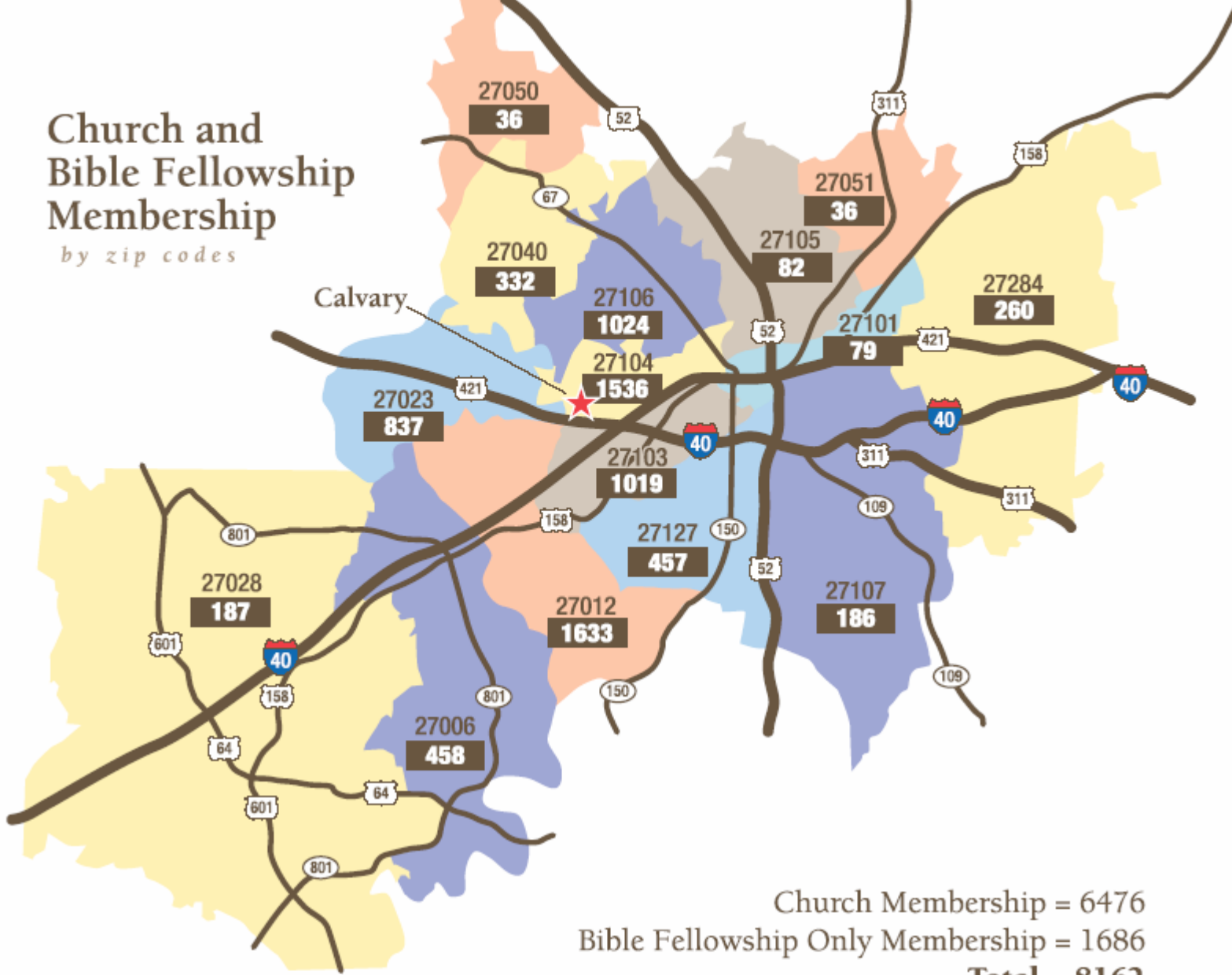
As we prayed through and examined potential locations for our Second Campus, we looked at Davie County's current and projected growth rates. Here is what we discovered :

- Davie County is the fastest growing county in the Triad (12 counties).
- Davie County is the 12th fastest growing county in the state of North Carolina.
- Population and growth rates show that Davie County is growing at a rate of 15%.
- 74% of the population is under the age of 55.

With the projected growth rate and trends we discovered in Davie County, we believe this is a very strategic location for our Second Campus.

Church and Bible Fellowship Membership

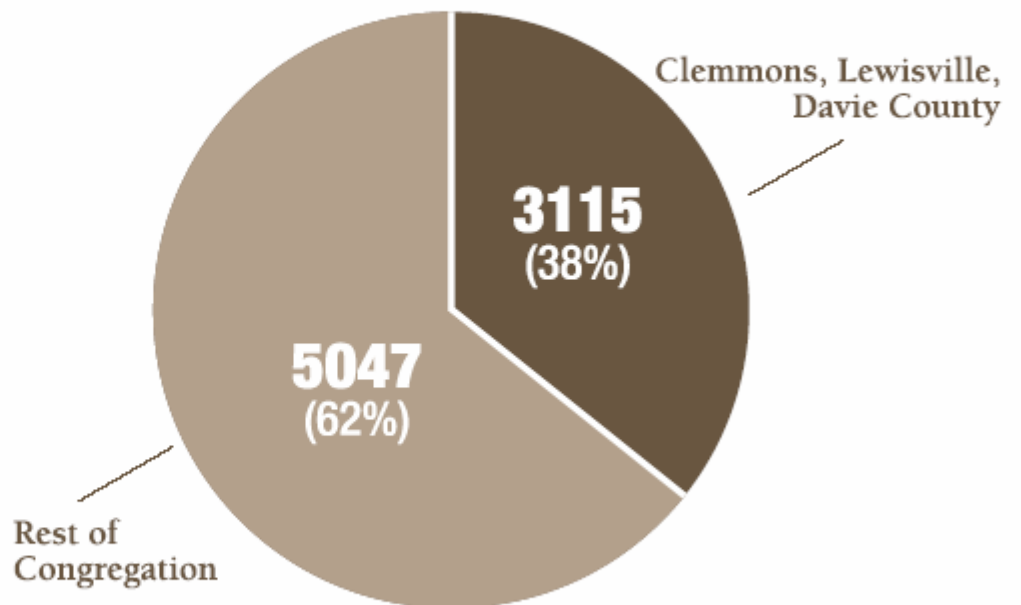

WHAT'S NEXT?

We have determined that Davie County is the general location for our Second Campus, but there is still much work to be done. Here is what to expect and how you can pray:

Facility

Over the next several weeks, we will continue working to secure a location for the West Campus to meet. We are looking at various options that include both permanent and temporary meeting spaces. As soon as this is determined, the deacons will bring a recommendation to the church that will include all details including usage, price, and financing options.

Leadership

The staff, along with the Second Campus Workgroup, will begin immediately recruiting and training the leadership for our West Campus. We still have an aggressive time table and are praying that God will allow us to begin meeting in the fall.
