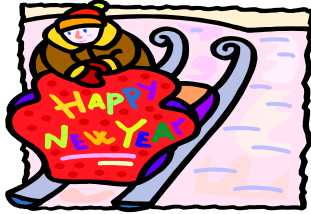

NEW CHOIR CD *POWER IN THE NAME* on the table down front. Cost is \$5

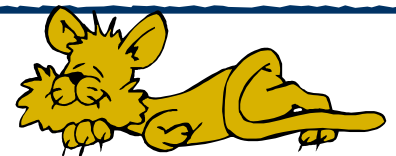
Dear Choir,
