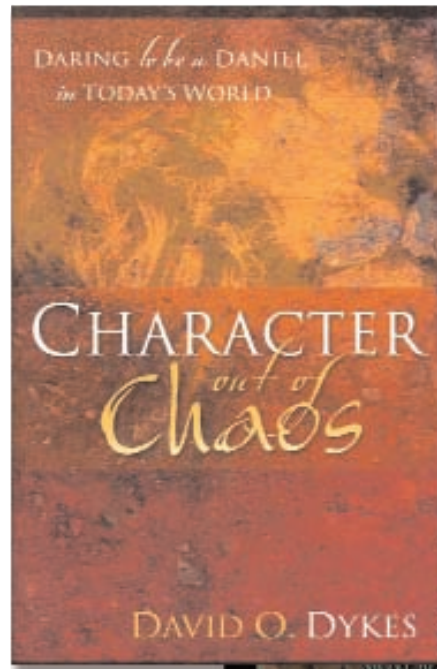


Character Out of Chaos: Daring to Be a Daniel in Today's World

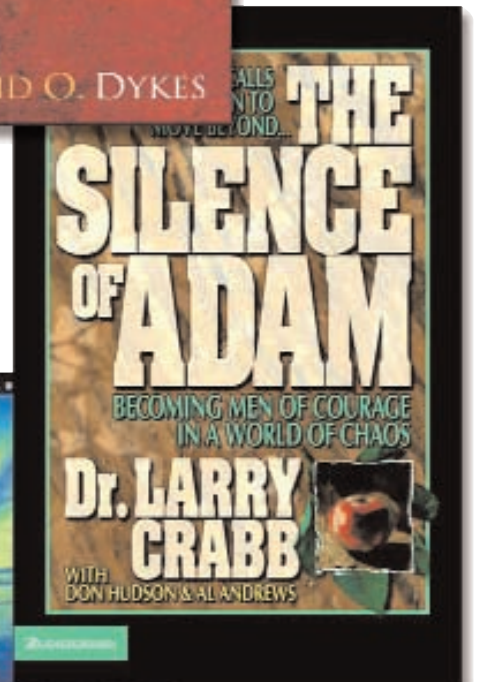
God Calls Men to Move Beyond The Silence of Adam: Becoming Men of Courage in a World of Chaos
