

This week Dr. Baucom continues the sermon series **All in the Family (of God)** with **O Brother** based on Hebrew 2:10-3:6.

1. If you have a brother (or sister), reflect on a fun or heartwarming memory you share with them. Such as a time he or she protected you, encouraged you, or embarrassed you. Enjoy the memories for a few minutes. Maybe take a moment to give them a call and share your feeling and thoughts with them. Share these memories and feeling with your IG group.
2. **Read and reflect on Hebrews 2:10-18.** Sit with the passage for several minutes. Read it again, slowly and reflectively **focusing on the relationship you share with Jesus as your brother.**
 - How do you feel knowing Jesus is not ashamed to call you His brother/sister?
 - How do you experience this relationship with him?
 - How does verse 14 say we are alike?
3. Read the following verses in which the High Priest is discussed.
 - ❑ **Hebrews 5:1-5**
 - ❑ **Hebrews 7:1-10**
 - ❑ **Psalms 110:4**
 - ❑ **Genesis 14:17-20**
 - ❑ **Hebrews 4:14-16**
 - What can you glean about the High Priest?
 - Who is Melchizedek?
4. **Read and reflect on Exodus 28.** Sit with the passage for several minutes, focusing on the **description of the High Priest's garments** in this chapter.
 - What, if anything, stood out in your mind?
 - Why do you think there is such a specific description of the garments to be worn by priests?
 - What have you learned about priests through reflecting on this passage?
5. **Read and reflect on Hebrews 5:1-10.**
 - What does this passage say about qualifications of a High Priest?
 - Where does a High Priest receive his calling?
 - How does Jesus become our High Priest?
6. **Read and reflect on Hebrews 3:1-10.**
 - After reflection, what does the passage say to you about your relationship with Jesus? Do you see Him any differently?
 - Where are we to fix our thoughts?
 - Where does our High Priest receive his calling?
 - What have you learned? What insights have you gained?
7. Reflect on all that you have learned. How has your relationship with Jesus deepened? How do you understand Jesus to intercede on your behalf? How might you intercede for others?

Invite your IG to a time of prayer where you intercede for one another before God.
