

WHO DO THEY SAY THAT HE IS? During this series, we will explore how other faiths view Jesus Christ in light of our own expressions of faith in Him as Savior and Lord. This week we will study **Hebrews 7:22-28** with Pastor Greg Loewer as he asks the question, *Who Does the Unification Church Say He Is?*

1. We live in a debt collecting society. Many have credit card debt that is difficult to stay up with, let alone pay off. Has anyone ever helped you pay a debt that you were unable to cover? How did that feel? Did you receive a letter confirming that all your debt had been paid? What did you do? Share your stories and insights with your group.
2. **Read and reflect on Hebrew 7:22-28.** Sit and reflect with this passage for about 10 minutes. **Reread it again** aloud, listening carefully to each word.
 - What does this passage reveal to you about the nature and character of Jesus?
 - What does **verse 27** indicate about Jesus' sacrifice for us?
3. Read the following verses and compare what they say about how often Christ needs to die for our sins.
 - **Hebrews 10:10**
 - **Hebrews 9:12, 28**
 - **Romans 6:8-10**
 - **I Peter 3:18**

4. In the following passage, what warning do we receive concerning false teachers and prophets?
 - **Matthew 24: 4-5, 23-25**
 - **Matthew 7:15-20**
 - **2 Peter 2:13**
 - **Luke 20:45-47**
 - Think about how we recognize false teachers today.
 - Have you encountered such a false teacher? If so, share your story with your group.
 - Share with your group insight you may have received.
5. **Read John 19:30 and John 17:4.**
 - What do these passages say about Jesus?
 - What does it say about His paying for our debt?
 - What does it indicate about the power of Jesus' sacrifice on the cross?
6. Reflecting on your study this week, were you able to discover anything that Christ still needs to do for our salvation?
7. What have you learned about the nature and character of Christ this week?

Spend time in praying to Abba. Share with Him your feelings concerning the gift of salvation you have received through Christ's sacrifice. Pray He continues to reveal Christ to you in new and growing ways in the days and weeks ahead.
