

Morning: “Getting Dressed for Christmas”
(The Worthy Walk-Purity) Ephesians 4:17-29

I. Put off the Grave clothes of impurity in the old life. “Putting off concerning your former conduct the old man.” Ephesians 4:22

“Put off the old self (old man, old life)” which is marked by:

- A Wasted **Mind**— “No longer walk in the futility (emptiness) of their mind.” Ephesians 4:17
- Separation from Our **Maker**— “Being alienated from the life of God because of ignorance...the blindness (hardness) of their heart.” Ephesians 4:18
- Impure **Morality**— “Who being past feeling have given themselves over to sensuality so as to indulge in every kind of impurity with greediness for more.” Ephesians 4:19
- Eternal **Misery**— “The old man which grows corrupt (worse and worse to final ruin)” Ephesians 4:22

II. Put on the Grace Clothes of **purity** in the New Life.

“Put on the new man which was created to be like God.” Ephesians 4:24

- Put on Holiness— “Put on the new man which was created...in holiness” Ephesians 4:24, II Corinthians 5:17, Galatians 2:20
- Put **Honesty**— “Wherefore put away lying, speak every man the truth with his neighbor...let him that stole, steal no more.” Ephesians 4:25
- Put on Harmony— “Be angry and sin not; let not the sun go down on your wrath.” Ephesians 4:26
- Put on Helpfulness— “Let no more corrupt (unwholesome) word proceed out of your mouth...but what is good that may impart grace to the hearers.” Ephesians 4:29
- Put on **Him**— “Indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as truth that is in Jesus.” Ephesians 4:21
