

Sermon Notes for February 11, 2007 A.M.

Morning: "A Christian World View" I Corinthians 1:1-31 (Pew Bible page 1012)
(The Mind of Christ)

A "world view" is a comprehensive way of looking at the whole of life which determines your thinking and actions. The Holy Spirit shares with the Corinthian Church and is a Christian world view which will give us wisdom, and "the Mind of Christ." (I Corinthians 2:16)

- ❖ A **City**— I Corinthians 1:1-2a— "Unto the Church of God which is **at Corinth**, to them who are sanctified **in Christ** Jesus."
 - You are in **this** world **in** Christ to do God's will.

- ❖ A **Call**— I Corinthians 1:2b-17— "**Called** to be saints, with all that in every place **call** upon the name of Jesus Christ."
 - You are **called** to something outside of yourself through the will of God.
 - **Holy** Lives— I Corinthians 1:2
 - **Ministry** for Christ— I Corinthians 1:3-8
 - **Fellowship** with the Church— I Corinthians 1:9-17

- ❖ A **Cross**— I Corinthians 1:18-25— "For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish **foolishness**, but unto us who are saved, it is the **power** of God."
 - Your world view comes together at the foot of the cross in the will of God.
 - The Cross is **Foolishness** to the World—I Corinthians 1:21
 - The Cross is **Wisdom** to the Lord—I Corinthians 1:23-25

- ❖ A **Crown**—I Corinthians 1:26-31— "That no flesh should glory (boast) in His presence . . . As it is written, He that glories (boasts), let him glory in the Lord."
 - Your fulfillment comes in life and world view comes in living only for **His** glory.
