on His agenda, using the talents I have been given in ways that are eternally significant."

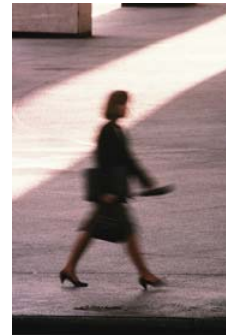

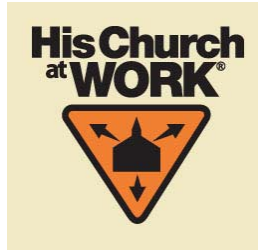
