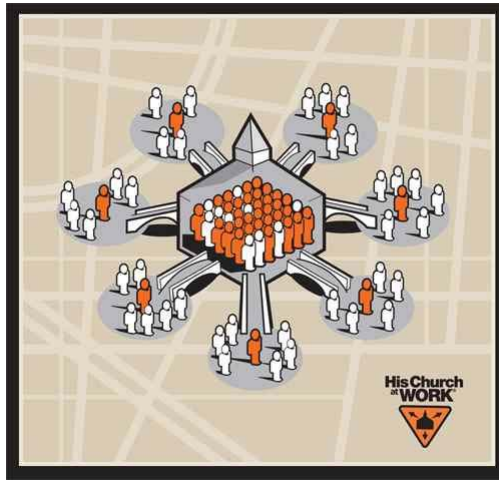

According to recent findings from the Barna Research Group:

- **Most Christians** will die without leading a single person to Christ
- **Most Christians** believe that if they are not gifted in evangelism, such outreach is not a significant responsibility for them
- **Only 9%** of all born-again adults have a biblical worldview
- **Over 50%** of Christians have never even heard a sermon on work
