BILTMORE BAPTIST REALIGNS FOR WORKLIFE IMPACT



The leaders of **Biltmore Baptist Church** in Asheville, NC have recognized that the church's greatest influence is through the work lives of its people. On May 13th Senior Pastor **Dr. James Walker** (pictured) shared with the congregation about the upcoming transformation. Dr Walker used the analogy of moving the church from a

"cruise ship" mentality as it relates to WorkLife and transforming the church into an "aircraft carrier" that will intentionally equip and launch its people to leverage their talents at work and to be strong ambassadors for Christ. **Kent Withington**, retired from Pfizer, will enter the role of WorkLife Director to help lead the transformation.

- **Affirmation** - Growing a Sense of Calling
- **Ability** - Growing a Sense of Service
- **Authenticity** - Growing a Sense of Influence
- **Alliance** - Growing a Sense of Relationship
