

Dear ministry friend,

I'm delighted to share with you the "God-sightings" we witnessed in 2007! This past year, God faithfully led Kingdom Building Ministries forward using itinerant speakers, newly designed training programs and spiritual growth resources (books, articles, audio messages, etc.) to perpetuate a movement of reproducing Kingdom laborers worldwide. Ministry results escalated higher than previous years as God took many people to deep places of commitment and service to him.

We received countless reports from KBM training alumni whose lives of influence God has employed across our nation and around the world. They are building God's Kingdom in strategic—new, remote, difficult, dark, important, and hard-to-reach—locations everywhere! We produced more print and audio spiritual growth resources than ever before in our history. Simply put, God worked miracles this past year in accomplishing more than we could have conceived possible! Let me share a few of those God-sightings with you:



- ♦ Six new associate speakers joined the KBM Itinerant Speaking Team.
- ♦ Speaker Orientation, Speaker Retreats and Speaker Advances in 2007 created synergy and catapulted speaking ministries forward.
- ♦ Efreem Smith rejoined the KBM Itinerant Speaking Team, adding a number of large and strategic events to our speaking schedule.
- ♦ KBM speakers spoke in many varying locations and venues including: India, Africa, Mexico; 25 of the 50 states (Hawaii, Alaska, California, New York, Florida, Oregon, Maryland, Arizona, and more); high schools, colleges, universities, Promise Keepers stadium events, women's events, large outdoor festivals, Hollywood Bible studies, FCA groups, Young President's Organization (YPO), corporate company parties, conventions, churches, youth camps, etc.
- ♦ At KBM's 2007 speaking events 59,215 spiritual decisions were made. Of those decisions 6,796 were first-time conversions and 37,187 were re-commitments to Christ. Each soul represents a life of influence!
- ♦ *16 Days*, an all new discipleship training program for youth, was successfully launched that incorporated content from Dwight Robertson's book *Plan A...And There's No Plan B*.
- ♦ *The Laborer's Institute* young adult discipleship training initiative was redesigned. The pilot program, *The Experience*, will be launched summer 2008.
- ♦ "Plan A" training conferences were developed and launched in partnership with churches and other strategic ministries.
- ♦ KBM's ministry partnership with Ichthus Ministries of Wilmore, KY continued to deepen as plans were developed to launch various co-operative ministry initiatives in 2009.

- ♦ Strategic meetings with publishers, consultants, literary agents, entertainment lawyers, writers, editors, and other publishing support professionals enabled the launch of KBM Publishing and KBM Digital Media.
- ♦ New print resources were developed and released under KBM Publishing. *Living a Plan A Life*, a church and small group study guide for the book, *Plan A...And There's No Plan B*, was among them.
- ♦ An indigenous leaders training conference and mobilization initiative was designed for spring 2008 launch among the Maasai people of southern Kenya.
- ♦ A strategic ministry partnership with key Christian leaders in India was developed that will facilitate international expansion of the "Plan A Message" throughout India in the fall of 2008.
- ♦ New staff member, Brian Musselman, was hired to fill the Director of Development position.
- ♦ KBM's annual new constituent database growth doubled in 2007.
- ♦ A 172% annual increase in gross product sales income funded more ministry outreach and growth.
- ♦ December 2007 marked KBM's largest giving month in 21 years of ministry. Glory to God as he faithfully provides!

YOU had so much to do with the above, and more! God's Kingdom goes forth through the prayers, encouragement, financial giving, volunteer efforts and earnest service of God's people. We're a team!

As 2007 came to a close, I also experienced many personal milestones. This past year I turned 50, my daughter turned 15, my son turned 10, and Dawn and I celebrated our 20th wedding anniversary. These special occasions marked time in a new way for me, making me even more aware of how fleeting our lives are. Scripture refers to the brevity of our lifespan as "like a vapor."
