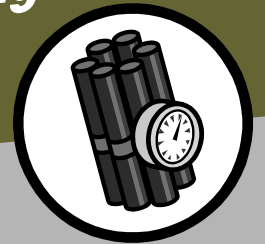

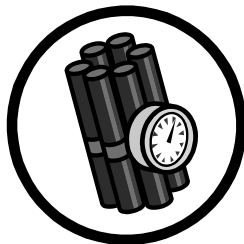

 - High-speed broadband Internet connection (hard-wired, not wireless service) with a minimum download speed of 750kbps and a computer with a Pentium III or better processor with at least 516Kb of RAM.
 - A Windows Media player
 - A screen, TV monitor, and amplified sound system appropriate to the room and group size
 - Network interface card wired and connected to a broadband router
