Ken Hoagland is a private consultant who has worked on a variety of issues including national tax policy, healthcare policy, aviation safety, and telecommunications issues. - He began his career in public policy working for former Texas Governor Dolph Briscoe devising economic development projects and policy on the Texas/Mexico border.
- In the years since, Mr. Hoagland has worked as a national lobbyist for senior citizens, as a national spokesman, and speechwriter.
- He developed employment and training programs for the U.S. Department of Labor and economic development programs for the State of Texas.
- He was one of the first national political strategists to develop powerful grassroots campaigns which put hundreds of thousands of citizens directly in touch with their legislators.
- He developed the grassroots campaign for Texans for Lawsuit Reform that resulted in sweeping changes to Texas' civil justice laws over the last ten years.

Because of his recognized expertise, Mr. Hoagland is a frequent guest on the media and has appeared on hundreds of radio and television news and public affairs programs. He has authored guest editorials in *The Washington Post*, *The New York Times*, and most Texas newspapers.

He has resided in Houston for the past 16 years, is married, and has two sons.
